When I need to start a horse very scared and fearful, I have some problems that do not know how to solve, then just winning the horse with insistence, but not with violence.

Some do not LICKING and not CHEWING the air, when they chewing not bowing down their head. I do not know if I'm doing it right when the job takes longer than an hour.

What should I do?

Leave the job for another day, and resume from the point zero? Or should I continue as I have been doing the insistence?

Indeed, the insistence I do not like the result. Why the horse does not show full confidence in me. But he trust me with time.

I consider you my best friend, for your love with horses.

I would like to meet you in person someday. God willing.

I have read are of your book and I am interested in your methods, especially Join-Up. I would like to know if I can apply it with Horacy. I don't know if this method will help donkey like horse. I will be thankful for your advice. I look forward to hearing from you.

Monty's Answer:

Donkey's are wonderful characters but they have some unique characteristics. They will not continue flight distance around the round pen any where near as far as a normal horse. Their Join-Up varies greatly from one individual to another. They are extremely intelligent, so you should not feel that it is the donkey's fault. You simply need to get the language right in order to be effective.

Inspirational interview: California Chrome's trainer, Art Sherman

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (WDRB) - Everybody today is talking about California Chrome owner Steve Coburn. He called the winners of the Belmont Stakes, and anybody who ran in the Belmont without running in the Preakness or Kentucky Derby "cowards" and "cheaters."

You'll see his face all over ESPN. He was splashed across the New York Post under the headline, "Triple Clown." Fewer people today are going to talk about Art Sherman. California Chrome's 77-year-old trainer showed up at his colt's barn this morning, and did exactly what you would expect an old horseman to do.

He showed how someone is supposed to act when he loses. You're going to see and read a lot about the more flamboyant Coburn in the coming days. I thought it was important, however, that you also read what Sherman said, so I've included most of his remarks here.

He first talked about his horse's condition.

"He had a big chunk of his quarter taken out," Sherman said. "He did that in the first jump. I have a still picture of the No. 3 horse coming over and hitting his right front and taking a big chunk out of it. But, you know, if that's the only thing - I can heal that up in about 2-3 weeks. And then we'll stop on him for about six or seven weeks and give him some pasture time. So Chrome is going to have some needed rest. It's been a tough campaign for him."


