

MONTY ANSWERS

Question: What are important things to check on your horse before transporting them in the winter, can you do anything to avoid them slipping on ice or wet trailer floors?

Answer: The best way to protect a horse's feet is to cover the foot with rubber hoof boots. This will allow the horse's feet to stand up off the ice. In addition, it will reduce the potential for a horse slipping on icy surfaces. You could check with your veterinarian as to substances you can place in the boot that will aid the foot in fending off ice and offensive moisture. If conditions are extreme, a veterinarian from the local geographic area will probably have some good words of advice.
